DANIEL O'CONNELL

O'Connell was the founder of Irish popular politics, whether we look on him as a great statesman or as the founder of the modern party system. He was also of historical importance in Western Europe being the first person to propose a happy marriage between Catholicism and electoral democracy, what was later called Christian Democracy. In Great Britain his importance to liberal reform transcended his role as an Irish leader. In the United States those schooled in his ideas of mass democracy rapidly copied his methods. He was remarkably liberal, realizing and urging not only the potential of, and need for, an alliance between Christianity and the emerging democratic forces, but also of the liberation of women and slaves, as well as the emancipation of Jews. He was, of course, a famous lawyer and played a prominent part in Irish business.

As a highly political thinker, as the founder of Irish the modern political system, O'Connell's ideals are of continuing national and international relevance. What can now be built on his heritage? It is the aim of The School to study this many-sided man, the unique qualities of his thought and performance, and the modern application of these legacies.

THE SCHOOL 2013

The Daniel O'Connell School will be held on Friday / Saturday, 6 / 7 September 2013. The overall purpose of the School will be to examine aspects of the historical career of Daniel O'Connell as well as to consider the challenges which they pose for the direction of modern Ireland. The School will present these themes in five sessions which are informed by O'Connell's own public career: Catholic Emancipation, Reform, Repeal, Leadership and Human Rights.

The School will be held over two days in Cahersiveen and Derrynane. The School is free and open to all.
